Area Coordinator

Carole Lowe said that all DKG events are on hold due to the pandemic. As information becomes available, she will share it.

Treasurer's Report

Cathy Harris reported that the bank balance is \$2,963.28. It's time to pay dues of \$85 to Cathy Harris.

Committee Reports

Programs and Services—-It was decided that contributions for The Sunshine Camp will be mailed to Cathy Harris with the dues check. Each person will determine how much to send. When the total amount is collected, the chapter will decide how to use the money to support The Sunshine Camp.

State—- Register for STAR July 15-17, 2022. The Programs and Services committee has ideas for virtual programs and projects. Applications due April 1st for the position of Executive Assistant of TSO. Members should have received the Lone Star News in the mail.

New Business

Patti Groce moved that at the following contributions be made by April 1. \$25 Emergency fund. \$15 Leadership, \$15 Scholarship, \$15 Projects. The motion was approved by voice vote. Laura Packard agreed to buy a \$10 gift card to be sent to ASTEF for the state convention. DKG International is studying the possibility of selling headquarters in Austin. An historical designation was denied by the City of Austin.
